WARNING

Under Vermont Law, an equine activity sponsor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities that are obvious and necessary, pursuant to 12 V.S.A. § 1039.

I acknowledge that the sport of horseback riding and driving, as well as working around or being in close proximity to horses, is inherently dangerous, and that serious injury and death can occur. By signing this release and waiver, I agree that if any injury occurs to me or my horse or to any equipment that I may use or send for use, I will make no claim against the organization, landowners, organizers, participants, assistants, or volunteers; I further agree to hold the organization, landowners, trainers, participants, assistants and volunteers free and harmless from any liability, claims, suits, or damages of whatsoever kind or nature that may be occasioned by the horses used by me or the negligence of the persons in charge of such horses; and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organization and individuals against all liability, claims, suits and expenses including attorney fees incurred, arising out of any injury to any person or damage to any property caused by me, my horse or attendants.

Land's End Farm Information and Barn Rules

- No dogs – please leave your dogs at home.
- Bring your own buckets, hay and grain.
- Goodies are always welcome! We request that attendees bring a dish for our potluck meals on clinic weekends, and we have had some AMAZING meals. There's a fridge and microwave at the barn, and of course a full kitchen at the rental house, so cooling and reheating are no problem.
- Vermont state law requires a current Coggins, rabies certificate, and health certificate for each horse you bring.
- Helmets are required for riders and drivers. Gloves are strongly recommended.

Other Accommodations

There is limited space for tent camping at Land's End Farm. Please check with Sue for availability.

We occasionally have the use of a rental house next door to the farm. Rental house pricing is \$50 per person per night, but please check with Sue as early as possible to be sure it's available.
